The liner serves as a warm vest or jacket for moderate weather. Finally, the jacket with the zip-out removed serves as a lightweight rain jacket.

With the introduction of the new Parka jacket, we must enforce a policy of distribution. The new jackets will be issued to employees after they complete 60 days of employment with ACMS and the largest size available is a 5XL. We're excited about the versatility of this jacket as it will replace the issuance of rain-jackets and light-weight jackets.

Winter Gloves: The Ninja Ice Hi Vis Glove is engineered to provide the highest level of warmth and flexibility. This Ninja Glove includes a unique shell and polymer combination incorporating the latest in hand protection technology with a range of dexterity and a sense of touch. It repels liquids while providing a strong wet or dry grip.

Yaktrax: Yaktrax are an ice traction device that fit on the bottom of your shoes that provide solid, predictable traction in any condition. Yaktrax will come in 2 adjustable sizes, Regular that fits size 5 to 12 shoe sizes and Large that fits from 13 to 16 shoe sizes. Once the Yaktrax have been issued to an employee, they **MUST** be worn in inclement weather to prevent any potential incident. In Snow and sleek weather these are a must.
